Overview

The new cable is 9,414 km long and consists of two segments. The southern segment interconnects Morocco with Côte d'Ivoire, Togo, Benin, Gabon, and Mauritania through seven landing points on a route of 8,600km. Commissioned in July 2021, it provides a capacity of 20Tbps. particular in West and Central Africa, as well as Eastern Africa. When it was first announce in May 2020, 2Africa was 37,000 km in length, connecting 23 countries, including 21 landings in 16.
