What should the distance be between the floor and the distribution board or main switch?

Approved Document M of the Building Regulations states that consumer units/fuseboxes should be mounted so that the switches are 1350-1450mm above floor level. Working space: The front clearance, side clearance, and height clearance requirements for electrical equipment that provide a safe area for maintenance, inspections, and other work. The main distribution box (or distribution room) shall be set up. 5M adequate support to be provided to carry the weight of the busbar by means of galvanized fixing brackets; comprising hanger clamp, fixing channel and damping screw, supplied by the busbar trunking manufacturer. iGCSE Computer Science:.. The working zero line in the distribution board and switch box shall be connected with the wiring terminal board, and the protective zero line shall be separated

Wherever more than one phase cannot be avoided, a minimum distance of 2.0 metres shall be maintained between any outlets, accessory or appliance connected to different phases of the supply.

Key Points Of Installation And Collocation Of Distribution Box In ...

The wire inlets and outlets in the distribution box and switch box shall be set at the lower bottom of the box. It is strictly prohibited to set them at the top, side, back or door of the box.
