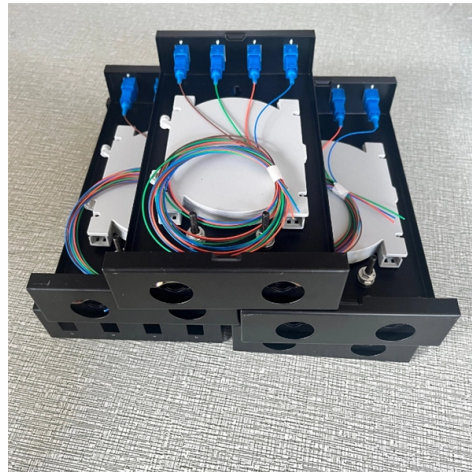


## Drilling holes to wires while the distribution box is obstructing access



### Overview

Avoid drilling holes on the sides of the box to prevent incoming/outgoing wires from contacting grounding or neutral wires, which poses a significant safety hazard.

**Accessibility:** For wall-mounted distribution boxes, ensure the door can open to at least 180° for full access to.
