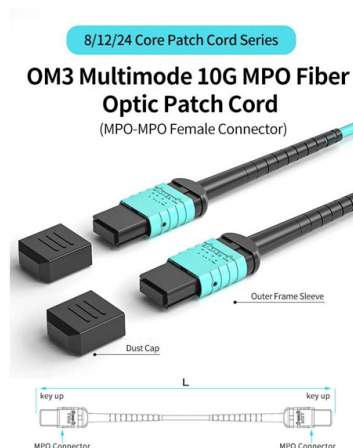


Elevation of wiring terminals in distribution box
