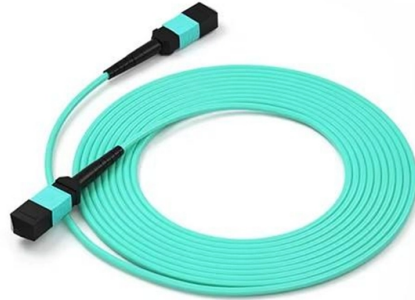


## Equatorial Guinea Fiber Optic Trench
