We then. Baseline characteristics were collected including age, gender, mechanism of injury (blunt versus penetrating), number of rib fractures, presence of flail chest, Injury Severity Score (ISS), chest Abbreviated Injury Scale score (c-AIS) and number of days from the time of injury when the tube was inserted. Primary outcome measured was failure rates fo. To estimate the sample size, we used primary end-point failure rate to calculate the needed sample size. The existing literature, including our 2 prior studies comparing PCs to CTs for draining traumatic HTX/HPTX, estimated the failure rate for CTs to be 15-30% [3, 11, 12]. Previous observational and retrospective studies reported PC failure rates.
