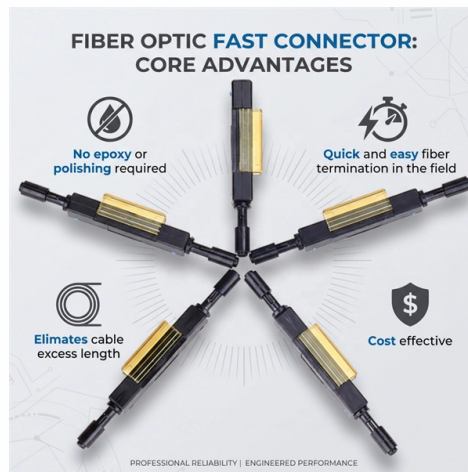


Network server racks should be placed inside the racks leaving empty spaces
